TRACY POLICE DEPARTMENT RELEASES VIDEO RELATED TO HOMICIDE CASE

Investigators asking for public's help to identify person seen on video.

Tracy, Calif. – The Tracy Police Department is requesting the public's help to identify a potential witness as they investigate the homicide of 64-year-old Tracy resident Parmjit Singh. Tracy Police Department has released a [video](#) of a person seen in the area of Gretchen Talley Park Sunday night, around the time that Parmjit Singh was discovered by officers suffering from an injury that he, sadly, did not survive. Investigators are enlisting the public's help to identify and locate the person seen in the video so police can obtain a statement from them about what they may have seen that night.

On Sunday, August 25th at 9:05 PM, Tracy Police officers responded to a report of a person bleeding on Dove Drive, near Egret Drive, in front of Gretchen Talley Park in Tracy. Officers arrived a few minutes later to find the victim, Mr. Parmjit Singh, in the roadway suffering a traumatic injury. Unfortunately, Mr. Singh passed away at the scene and Tracy Police Department is actively investigating the death as a homicide. No further information is being released at this time.

City and police officials met with members of the community yesterday to provide an update on the investigation, offer support and address concerns raised about safety and lighting in City parks. *"We take pride in our safe, close-knit community,"* said Mayor Robert Rickman. *"The loss of one of our own to violence has shaken us to our core and is felt by the entire community. On behalf of the Tracy City Council, we offer our sincerest condolences to Mr. Singh's family, friends and to the members of our Sikh community. This violence will not be tolerated and we are dedicating every available resource to ensuring that the person(s) responsible for the death of Mr. Singh is brought to justice."*
